Acceptance of tuition, whether partial or in full, does not obligate Learning Strategies Corporation (LSC) to accept the application. Written notice of acceptance with a confirmation of class schedule will be given to each student in writing. (In the event that the application is rejected, all fees will be refunded and written notice given.) The date of execution of the enrollment agreement is the date of delivery of the notice of acceptance, and if delivered by mail, the postmark date of the letter of acceptance. LSC reserves the right to terminate any student whose conduct discredits the professional and ethical standards of LSC or any student who does not display a positive and receptive attitude toward learning these techniques.

**BUYERS RIGHT TO CANCEL.** Notwithstanding anything to the contrary, LSC shall refund all tuition, fees and other charges paid by a student, if the student gives written notice of cancellation within five business days after the day on which this Enrollment Agreement is executed regardless of whether the course of instruction has started. Written notice of cancellation shall take place on the date the letter of cancellation is postmarked, the date a fax is received by LSC, the date time-stamped on an email when received by LSC, or the date the notice is hand delivered to LSC.

Students cancelling after five business days following the day of execution of this contract, but before the start of class shall be refunded all but 15% of total tuition, fees and other charges which shall not exceed \$50. The date of execution of this contract shall be presumed to be the date of delivery of the notice of acceptance and if delivered by mail, the postmarked date of the letter of acceptance.

When a student has been accepted by LSC and gives a written notice of cancellation after the start of the course of instruction, but before completing 75% of the course, the amount charged for the completed portion of the course shall not exceed the prorata portion of the total charges for tuition, fees and all other charges that the length of the completed portion of the course bears to its total length, plus 25% of the total cost of the course, but not to exceed \$100. After completion of 75% of the course, no refunds shall be given. Cancellations must be made in writing to LSC. Student Course Materials shall be returned to LSC. (No promissory instrument will be negotiated prior to completion of 50% of the course.)

A student shall receive a full refund if LSC cancels a class in which the student is enrolled.

LSC shall acknowledge in writing any valid notice of cancellation within 10

business days after the receipt of such notice and within 30 business days shall refund to the student any amounts due him and arrange for termination of the student's obligation to pay any sum in excess of that due under the cancellation and refund policy.

The right to cancel and receive a refund, as outlined above, is not conditional upon compliance with LSC's regulations or rules of conduct.

**SATISFACTION GUARANTEE.** LSC guarantees satisfaction in the PhotoReading program according to the following. A student may request a full refund if the student is dissatisfied with the instructor, course content, course materials, or the way the course is being presented after the student has attended one class session and before the second is scheduled to begin.

After attending the full program, a student may request a refund, except for 15%, providing the student demonstrates that he/she has completed the course assignments. This request must be delivered to LSC within 60 days of beginning the class.

All requests for refunds shall be made in writing to LSC. All Student Course Materials shall be returned to LSC to receive a refund.

This agreement becomes a legally binding instrument upon written acceptance of the student unless cancelled pursuant to the Buyers Right to Cancel.

Learning Strategies Corporation is licensed by the Minnesota Higher Education Services Office as a Private Vocational School to present PhotoReading courses. "PhotoReading," a registered servicemark, is owned exclusively by Learning Strategies Corporation worldwide.

The officers of the company are Paul R. Scheele, Peter Bissonette, William J. Erickson, and David A. Heit.

**CALENDAR.** Learning Strategies Corporation offers classes throughout the year. Class dates accompany this document. Classes in the United States are not scheduled on the following national holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, The Fourth of July, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. If a class is scheduled to meet on the day of another holiday the student wishes to observe, the student should not enroll in that class.

**ENROLLMENT POLICY.** Students may enroll for courses up until the beginning of class providing that there are course materials and space available. Entrance requirements for the PhotoReading course are:

Students in open-enrollment programs are to be above the age of 18. They are to be literate adults with a measured reading speed of at least 120 words per minute and comprehension score of at least 40 percent on an 11th grade reading comprehension test. If a person under the age of 18 requests admission, consent of the student's parent or guardian and a personal interview with an authorized Learning Strategies Corporation staff member is required. This staff member will make a subjective determination of the maturity of the student and his/her ability to grasp concepts such as the use of the other-than-conscious mind.

**CLASS ATTENDANCE.** Attendance in all the sessions of a class is mandatory for completion of a course. Students may make-up certain sessions if there are openings in other classes. Students are expected to arrive before the scheduled session times. Students can miss vital information by being tardy.

**RETAKING CLASSES.** Five positions are held in each open-enrollment class that is sponsored by Learning Strategies Corporation until 10 business days before a class. These positions are for PhotoReading graduates or for students needing to make-up a class. Graduates who feel they could benefit by retaking the course can retake the course at no charge other than for the cost of any new materials.

**FACILITIES.** Classes are offered at various locations around the world. The address and telephone number of the facilities of a particular class is available on request. Our office is located at 2000 Plymouth Road in Minnetonka, Minnesota.

**DESCRIPTION OF PHOTOREADING CLASS.** The Weekend Intensive Course consists of three class sessions which generally meet 6-9 pm on Friday, 9 am to 7 pm on Saturday, and 9 am to 6 pm on Sunday. Students are required to participate in class exercises and maintain a positive and open-minded attitude during the course. In addition, students are required to perform the following outside exercises: 1) listen to daily relaxation tapes, and 2) PhotoRead at least one book each day. The course is approximately 40% lecture and 60% exercises.

The objectives of the Photo-Reading courses are as follows: 1) to speed the input of information from written pages, 2) accelerate learning, 3) integrate and use information personally and professionally, and 4) increase the use of the other-than-conscious reserves of the mind.

(It is important for students to realize and accept that the experience of PhotoReading is quite different from the experience of reading—it is not the same as reading at 25,000 words per minute. Students must realize, too, that the course is not about developing an eidetic or true photographic memory of the pages. The course is about using the resources of your other-than-conscious-mind to get your reading done in the time available at the comprehension you need.)
